Meals On Wheels of Trenton/Ewing needs our help.

Meals On Wheels of Trenton/Ewing has been serving homebound seniors and people with disabilities since 1973. Last year, with the use of a network of volunteers, we served over 44,000 meals to more than 375 people. For many of our clients, our volunteers are the only friendly face they see every day. We are so much more than a meal.

Every year we provide our clients "Blizzard Bags". These bags are filled with nonperishable food items in the event of inclement weather when our volunteers cannot deliver a hot meal. As you can imagine last year was especially challenging. Typically, we solicit donations and end up purchasing most of the items in these bags from big-box stores. This year we have seen a 10% increase in our client roles, just in the first six months of the year. We have also experienced a loss in funding, which makes purchasing these items especially challenging. We do not want to discontinue the distribution of these vital bags, especially in light of the recent predictions of another bitter winter.

We are respectfully requesting the donation of the following food items for our Blizzard Bags. It is our hope to make up two bags this season, which means we will need 350 items of each of the following: Peanut Butter crackers, canned tuna fish, apple sauce, fruit cups, granola bars, Jiff-To-Go, individual Mac-N-Cheese, and individual canned soup. We would need these items by the third week of October. If it is easier for people to donate funds to purchase these items, we would gladly accept cash/checks as well, and of course acknowledge any donation. Last year we spent close to \$1,500 on the purchase of these items, and we only gave out one bag!
